Approve franchised partnerships

Sub-contractor (Franchise) typically colleges or universities who have established infrastructure to support teaching and learning of UK higher education. Able to meet due diligence standards financially, legally and in its quality assurance frameworks (UK OfS/QAA standard).

Recognised study centres

An arrangement where a partner institution is authorised to provide the infrastructure and study centre resources to students in the UK or overseas on Arden University programmes, which could include library and study facilities, local pastoral support, work-based learning sessions, study skills (inc. English language) workshops and other local services. The University will retain full responsibility for academic delivery, content and assessment of the programme.

Infrastructure Service Provider

An arrangement where a partner institution provides one or more infrastructure element to support delivery by the University, such as provision of premises, particular learning resources or facilities, with full responsibility for academic delivery and assessment of the programme being retained by the University.

Progression agreement

An arrangement where an organisation refers students from a specific programme of study delivered by the organisation for admission to a programme of study at Arden University. Students from the organisation are not guaranteed entry onto an Arden University programme of study.

Dual Award Partner

An arrangement through which a partner institution is authorised to deliver, assess and award a separate part of study on a dual programme (in English, except where otherwise agreed by the University) and the University delivers, assesses and awards a separate part. Usually a 50/50 split..
